Outside of that, I built a Python computer vision system that autonomously identifies resale opportunities across online marketplaces; it has generated real financial returns, with proceeds donated to Merchants Quay Ireland. I run a home lab with SIEM infrastructure, honeypots, and network segmentation — the kind of hands-on environment where you learn how systems actually break. I approach security from first principles: attacker mindset, failure modes, and building things that hold up under pressure.

EDMO operates under European Commission mandate, coordinating anti-disinformation research across all EU member states.

- Built a weekly fact-check round-up pipeline in Python: scrapes TheJournal.ie fact-checks, formats them to EDMO's house style, and posts drafts to edmo.ie via the WordPress REST API
- Ran a controlled two-account social media experiment documenting algorithmic radicalisation; presented findings to ~60 students
- Research shared by EDMO Ireland with DCU academics, under consideration for an MA journalism module
- Selected as one of four representing Ireland in the EU-funded ChangingTIDE Changemakers counter-disinformation programme (TEPSA, Brussels)
